Old Business:

Invoice Proposal from O'Leary Ash fault for proposed patch work mainly on the Palmer House Way section. Board determined that this should be tabled and reassessed after winter is complete.

Homeowner at 13933 Palmer House Way indicated that lighting at the visitor's section at that location is inadequate. possible options are the installation of one single LED lighting system, where power would be run directly from that owner's property location, and where the homeowner would incur the expense of that installation.

New Business:

(Answer) - All inspections and reviews have been completed by CSG, and now we are just waiting on Bids and Proposals to get started!

Homeowner follow-up inquiry relating to the proposed installation of a speedhump on Bruton Parish Way.

(Answer) - Traffic mirror was installed to create more visibility to aid in-coming and out-going drivers.

Frank stated he will visit that area again to see if the potential of maybe a single speedhump in a specific area could also be helpful.

Board will discuss again at our next meeting.

Homeowners in the Bruton Parish Way section reported that the snow removal company did not do a good job with cleaning snow form the

trash pads, and certain parking areas. Abaris will bring this to the attention of FSC to make sure that the Snow-Plow crew will do a complete cohesive
